This five-bay framed and weatherboarded I-house faces west onto Sedwick Street. Built in the early twentieth century, this structure has one surviving brick stove flue built along an interior partition wall. Each sash is glazed with a single pane of glass. The cornice of the gable roof extends continuously across the north gable end on the south side of the house and is an early or original two-story polygonal bay. A broad gabled dormer provides light for the attic story. The facade is sheltered by a hipped-roof one-story porch supported on Doric columns. There are several rear additions.


