This framed and weatherboarded shotgun dwelling faces south onto Point Lane. Set on a concrete-block foundation, it is a one-story framed and weatherboarded gable-roofed structure. It is two bays long and has a two-bay facade. The windows are glazed with two-over-two double-hung sash. There is a center ridgeline brick stove flue.

An older deteriorated square-plan vertical boarded gable-roofed outbuilding is located behind the house.

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
