This two-story framed and weatherboarded square-plan commercial building faces west onto Solomons Island Road. This structure is three bays wide and three bays deep with a pyramidal roof. The main entrance is located at the center of the facade. The windows are glazed with six-over-one double-hung sash. There is a central brick stove flue and a two-story rear ell. The original siding has been replaced with asbestos shingles. This structure dates to the early twentieth century.


