This two-story framed and weatherboarded structure faces west onto Solomons Island Road. It has two-bay and three-bay sections. The northern two-bay structure has a gable roof; the southern section has a hipped roof. Most of the second-story sash are six-over-one and double-hung. The first-story fenestration has been altered in connection with the building's use as a restaurant. There is a one-story one-bay shed built onto the south end and a new front awning. The building dates to the early twentieth century.


J. R. Langley and Sons operated an all-night restaurant here during the early twentieth century. It was best known as Langley's Lunchroom.
