DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Otto House is located on the south side of Sub-Station Road approximately one-half mile east of the Delaware State line, northwest of Hickman, Caroline County. The house appears to be an early nineteenth century structure whose interior has been removed and whose structure is in a badly deteriorated state.

The house is one story of stuccoed brick laid in common bond. The north facade has a central entrance flanked by a window to each side, and the south facade has two entrances with a window in the westernmost bay. The gable ends have no openings except for large attic windows in the clapboard covered gables. There is a shingled roof with stove flue chimney stacks. The interior is entirely stripped.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Otto House is an interesting survival of an early vernacular dwelling in Caroline. In form it was similar to the Nuttle House and probably had a hall and parlor plan originally. The building was later remodeled and is now stripped so that little of the early dwelling remains. It is, however, a place of human habitation for a long time and is possibly a significant historical archeological site.
