**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Richard Gadow House is located adjacent the Schmick House in Linchester. It is a late 19th century, two story frame dwelling with a 'T' plan constructed upon a brick foundation. It has an entrance and one window on the base of the 'T' and the end of the top facing the road is semi-octagonal beneath the standard gable. Each facet of the bay has a window and two on the center facet. Its southeast side, or top of the 'T' is three bays long plus a one bay leanto on the southwest. Two chimneys pierce the roof, one at the base of the 'T' and the other in the center of the top of the 'T'.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Gadow House was probably built in the 1890's reputedly by a Mr. Bradley. It was later the home of Clatie Hurley Trice who owned the house adjacent now called, The Schmick House.

Architecturally it is a smaller and simpler form of house frequently encountered in late 19th century Caroline County, both in town and rural settings. It was reputedly built for the grand sum of \$800.00 and sold at a profit.


