The former Denton Journal Building is a two story four bay wide brick building with a flat roof and brick cornice. A rectangular marble inset on the cornice bears the inscription "Denton Journal 1845-1901."

The first story has two storefronts: the east storefront has a recessed entranceway flanked by display windows; the west storefront retains the original transom light, although a swan's neck pediment over the door is a recent addition.

The second story 2/2 windows are set within segmental arches and have modern aluminum shutters.




