The Carter Building, one of the largest brick structures in downtown Denton, is two and one half stories high and twenty bays long with a low shed roof. There is some simple decorative brickwork present, including brick corbelling along the eaves and brick pilaster strips.

Windows on the first floor are modern shopfront ones while those on the second floor have 1/2 sash lights set within segmental arched openings.




