This building which dates from the c. 1920's shares several similarities with the Denton Hardware Company at 328 Market Street. Both are one story three bay flat roofed buildings constructed of coarse-faced concrete blocks. The facade gable is covered by a stepped facade with asphalt shingle finish. The double door entranceway is recessed between display windows with multi-paned transom lights.




