This house, still in excellent condition, is two and one half stories and topped by a hipped roof with cross gables. There is a bay window on the east facade; the gable above it is covered with wood shingles and has a bracketed cornice with pendants. The wraparound porch is supported by turned posts and has a gallery of turned balusters beneath the eaves. The porch balustrade was recently removed.




