This two-story, three bay wide frame house shows evidence of the Italianate style. It has a low pitched hip roof, paned windows with 2/2 sash and a one bay porch with bracketed eaves and chamfered posts.

The entrance has multi-paned side lights and transom light, a four panel door, and a screen door trimmed with spindles and brackets.

Alterations include the removal of brackets from the roofline and the application of asbestos siding.




