This c. 1900 house, a modified version of the carpenter Queen Anne style house, has an asymmetrical appearance due to a prominent square tower with pyramidal roof. The facade gable has cornice returns and fish-scale shingles.

The wrap-around porch is supported by unusually slender columns and the original door is notable for its carved decorative work.

The house has been altered by the addition of asbestos siding.




