This building, which until recently housed shops and apartments, underwent several alterations after the original construction date in the 1880s. The three bay gable front house had a two bay, shed roofed c. 1905 addition on the south elevation.

The facade gable featured twin 2/2 sash windows and a centered circular window surrounded by round arched wood moulding. The gable end was covered with vertical wood boards with a sawtooth lower edge.

The classical entranceway details included a pediment, fluted pilasters and a six panel door.


