**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

Upland Farm is located on the south side of Maryland Route 404 the Hillsboro-Denton Road, approximately eight-tenths of a mile east of Route 312. It is a late Federal style house probably built c. 1830-40.

The frame house is two storys with the main facade facing north. The west section of this facade is three bays with a side entrance plan and brick chimney inside the gable opposite the entrance. There is a one story one bay pil ster entrance porch and pilasters are repeated at the corners of the house. The doors are of a later date with round arch paneling, and a transom, side-lights and shutters. The lintels are dentiled with curved bracket ends. Also the cornice is dentiled, and there is a hipped roof with a late Chinese-style railed gallery. Attached to the east of this section is a two bay, two story gable roof addition. This section repeats the trim of the windows and cornice and has a three sided Victorian bay on the east gable. There is a four bay rear wing with a screened porch, pilasters and turned columns. The house site is nicely landscaped and has several farm buildings with curvilinear bargeboard.

## STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Upland Farm depicts the architectural changes, basically in ornamentation, that occurred in the nineteenth century. As a late Federal style house, it differs from the norm in Caroline County through its hipped roof with a railed gallery and the extensive dentil ornamentation.


