The house at 209 Fifth Avenue is typical of the Shingle style; both the second story and the gable ends are covered with dark brown shingles and the exposed framing is emphasized. The wide second story flares out over the stone first floor and there is a wrap-around porch with short Doric columns on low stone walls. There is a large oval window in the middle of the handsome wood front door.


