Based on available information the structure at 224 East Main Street, Preston, Maryland, is not located within the boundaries of a state listed historic district and does not meet the criteria for individual listing on the Maryland Register. The two story, frame, gable roofed house most likely dates from the late 19th-early 20th century and is a typical example of a vernacular domestic building for the period and lacks the architectural distinction and integrity to qualify for listing under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past, and thus does not qualify under Criteria A or B.


