The single-family residence located at 205 Park Avenue in Federalsburg, Caroline County, MD is not located in an historic district nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The house is a two-story, three-bay, frame I-house, probably built in the first decade of this century. The house follows a form typical of the period and lacks the architectural distinctiveness and integrity to qualify for listing on the National Register of Historic Places under Criterion C. The property is not known to have any associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria B or C.




