Located at 302 University Avenue, the Federalsburg Elementary School was originally constructed in 1935. Additions occurred in 1959, 1967 and 1980. The 1980 addition and alterations included partial demolition of the existing building as well as window replacements and entrance modifications. The oldest block is currently flanked by the non-historic sections. Due to a variety of alterations, the simple building no longer retains sufficient integrity of design, material, workmanship to be eligible. The school is located outside the historic district.






EXISTING FIRST FLOOR
