The property at 11164 Central Avenue in Ridgely, Caroline County, MD. is not located in an historic district, nor is it considered eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The property at 11164 Central Avenue is located in a rural setting, with cultivated land around it, and consists of a single-family dwelling and two domestic outbuildings. It is a two-story, frame house with a two-story rear ell. The walls are clad with what appears to be vinyl siding and the cross-gable roof is sheathed in asphalt shingles. Two small buildings, possibly a farm office (historically) and an equipment shed are located at the rear of the dwelling. The house and its associated domestic buildings are representative of the late 19th/early 20th-century rural domestic buildings of the period and lack the architectural distinctiveness necessary to qualify for listing on the National Register under Criterion C. The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past and thus does not meet Criteria A or B.


