Circa 1830-40

Tuckahoe Acres stands at Tuckahoe Road and Maryland Route 328, set back in the center of a prosperous farm. It is composed of two major sections and resembles Long Point Farm up the Neck. The chief difference between the two is the longer wing on Long Point. Beside the first half nineteenth century form and material, there is also a 20th Century porch at the main entrance which has a Greek Revival character.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Tuckahoe Acres stands on a farm on Tuckahoe Neck at the corner of Deep Branch Road and Md. Rt. 328.

The house is a two part frame building constructed in the first half of the 19th century. In form it resembles Long Point Farm near Hillsboro, although the lower portion is not as long as at Long Point.

Its facade is three bays long on the two and one-half story part and three bays long on the one and one-half story part. In front of the main door is a pedimented porch, Greek Revival in feeling, but dating from the 20th century. The windows have 6/6 sash and louvered shutters. The walls are covered with plain weatherboard. Within the north gable is a brick chimney and on the exterior of the south gable is another.

The wing is a lower structure and appears to pre-date the taller part as it possesses 9/6 sash windows and a chimney within each gable. It appears to have been a typical 'hall and parlor' plan house of the early 19th century which was incorporated into the present plan around the 1840-50 period.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Tuckahoe Acres is architecturally significant first as a good example of what it has become, a plan consisting of a living room and dining room with central stair passage, plus kitchen. And it is an example secondly of the earlier form of 'hall and parlor' without its original kitchen. In both cases it is a well constructed vernacular building.


