Pleasant Meadow Farm is an L-shaped stone farmhouse built into a bank with a full basement on the main facade and the side of the house with a double-tiered porch typical of this region's farmhouses. A datestone in the west gable ends has the year 1855 carved in it. The structure is an excellent example of mid-nineteenth century stone construction in this region with its two feet thick walls, splayed window jambs with paneling, and side-hall plan. The building also contains representative features for this period in its ornamentation, that includes a recessed, paneled doorway with a four-pane transom, raised paneled jambs, and fluted, engaged pilasters with a plain entablature.
