## SUMMARY:

The Brodbeck Road Bank Barn was representative of late 19th century barn construction in this region. It was of timber frame construction and built into a bank in the style popular in Carroll County. The gable window was dated 1888 and the building was demolished in June 1985.

## DESCRIPTION

The Brodbeck Road Bank Barn was located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Maryland Route 30 and Broadbeck Road. The barn was part of a farm complex that had been converted to commercial (junkyard) use during the 20th century. The house at the site was identified on the State Highways Survey and is recorded as CARR-587.

The barn was built on a fairly level site and constructed of frame covered in vertical siding. The forebay of the barn faced southwest and a portion of it had been filled in with concrete block during the 20th century. An earthen ramp was constructed on the northeast side that led to the threshing floor of the barn. The foundation was constructed of fieldstone. A gable window on the northwest gable end had the date "1888" painted on it. The roof was covered in sheet metal and had two ventilation cupola constructed of wood. The barn was demolished in June 1985.


