The frame house at 7565 Middleburg Road is a rural Victorian structure that uses the regional house form but updates it with Victorian ornamentation. The focus of this ornamentation is the two-story, five-sided projecting bay window with a gable-front roof. Across the other three bays of the main facade is a one-story porch with Victorian style bracket trim. The remainder of the house follows the regional type.
