The two lumber sheds, situated in a vertical line, are located south of the powerhouse. The lumber shed to the north is the older structure of the two and is identified as lumber shed #1. The shed to the south is the second lumber shed. The two wooden structures are very similar in appearance so that one description will suffice for both. The structure measures ten bays long and two bays wide and rests on both a cement foundation and cement piers. Rising one story, the building displays a shingled, gable roof. The structure faces east and it is the east side which is open and reveals the ten storage bins. The bins are closed off by hinged doors of wooden planks. The profile of the building from the south wall exhibits an unbalanced appearance because the gable roof on the east side is attached at the crest but hangs down somewhat independently, only supported by rafters due to the absence of the east wall.

The two lumber sheds are located in the industrial group where support functions for the hospital are housed. The earliest known date on the first lumber shed is 1924. The second shed was constructed in 1931 during a phase of hospital improvement. While neither shed is architecturally superior, the two structures moderately contribute to the built environment of the hospital as a representatives of the outbuildings necessary to keep the hospital operating efficiently.
