A full-width Anglo-influenced porch is located in the front with thin turned spindled proch supports. Ornamented with bracketed cornices around the roof. 1148 has one single brick chimney, and one half oval window on the side. It also has decorative brown wood shingles on either side of the front door.

This lot found at 1148-50 on Main Street in Hampstead, Maryland can be found on the 1862 Martenet's Map. Then, it was a community building owned by Joseph Ebaugh which consisted of a store and post office.

On February 25, 1848 John Lammott sold this lot to Joseph Ebaugh (8/130) on April 12, 1869. Joseph Ebaugh & wife sold lot #1 & 2 to Charles Murray (37/77) on December 30, 1910 Elwood L. Murray received lot #1 by deed from Charles Murray (116-84) on September 28, 1933 Elwood L. Murray and Lillian Murray bought lot #2 from Clayton and Emma Turner (160/57) on December 16, 1960 Elwood and Lillian Murray sold to Ralph G. Hoffman (329/691) on the same date, Ralph G. Hoffman sold back to Elwood Murray (329-693) on March 18, 1966 Elwood L. Murray willed this parcel of land to his nephew William J. Matthews (will 18/347) on June 28, 1967 Matthews sold to Ralph G. Hoffman (423/159). On the same date Ralph G. Hoffman sold the parcel of land to William and Elizabeth Mathews (423/161).

Today is again a community building: 1150 is the public library.
