Prepare both a summary paragraph and a general description of the resource and its various elements as it exists today.

This two-and-a-half-story foursquare, which appears to have been erected between 1920-1930, is intact with very little modernization or additions.

House (1920-1930)

This 2-1/2- story, rusticated-formstone-walled foursquare is two bays by two bays. One-over-one sash on all elevations is topped by rectangular stone lintels. A porch with decorative iron posts and railing traverses the principal [north] facade. The slate, hipped roof has a dormer on the north elevation and an interior brick chimney on the south. Notable decorative features of the house include its rusticated walls and contrasting lighter-colored quoins and lintels.

A 2-story, vinyl-sided addition, two bays by two bays, is affixed to the south elevation. A rectangular projection with quoining is located on the west elevation and there is quoining at all four corners of the main block.

The early history of the house is not known nor does it appear on the 1916 Rand Mc Nally Atlas. Its foursquare form suggests a date between 1920 and 1930.

The house is not eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not eligible under Criterion A; no significant events historically or agriculturally have been determined to be associated with the property. The property is not eligible under Criterion B; no persons significant in local, state or national history have been determined to have been associated with the property. The property is not eligible under Criterion C; the property is not a significant example of its type, design or manner of construction. There are more significant and intact examples of foursquares within the project area.
