Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

This one-story, simple dwelling was constructed ca. 1947. The rectangular building is faced with stucco. The front-gable end is clad with vinyl siding. The front-gable roof is sheathed with composition roll. The three-bay front contains a wood-paneled door with a large glass light. A one-story, hipped-roof porch spans the front (south) elevation. The open porch is supported by a concrete-block foundation and features small, square roof posts. The windows are one-over-one-light, double-hung sash replacement units. Original, paired six-over-six-light, wood-frame, double-hung sash are located in the front (south) gable end. An exterior stuccoed chimney and a wood-frame porch are located on the east elevation. A one-story, concrete-block garage is located behind the house.

The side-gabled roof is sheathed with composition roll. The south elevation contains two wood-paneled overhead garage doors with glass lights. A shed-roofed addition is attached to the west end of the garage.

This building originally was constructed as a residence during the 1940s. In 1943, members of the Ruch family, who had owned approximately 23 acres since 1904, sold a small parcel to Charles and Nellie Edmundson (Carroll County Land Records EOC 132:373; EAS 184:F543). The Edmundsons purchased additional land in 1951 (CCLR EAS 211:312). The house was built between 1943 and 1951.

The location of the house illustrates pre-World War II residential development along Liberty Road (MD 26). The first lots subdivided from historic farms, generally, were those fronting the road. Although the building retains integrity of location,


setting, feeling, and association, alterations to exterior treatment, windows, and porch have compromised its integrity of design, materials, and workmanship. The building is a common example of the numerous modest dwellings built during the second and third quarters of the twentieth century. However, the building does not possess those qualities of significance necessary for listing in the National Register of Historic Places. The building is an isolated resource located along a contemporary commercial corridor and is not associated with significant historical patterns (Criterion A) or with significant persons (Criterion B). The building does not possess the significance and integrity necessary for National Register consideration for its architectural design (Criterion C).
