Based on the available information, the house at 1307 Ellis Drive does not appear to meet the National Register criteria for listing. The house is located outside of the Mount Airy Historic District. The frame gable roofed house, which probably dates to the mid- or late 18th century, does not appear to have any architectural significance. Moreover, it has undergone substantial alterations, losing much of its historic character. The property is not known to be associated with any significant event or person.
