Based on the available information, 2012 Hoover Mill Road does not meet the National Register criteria for individual listing, nor is it located in any known historic district. The two story brick house was probably constructed in the mid 19th century. It is a common farm house type in Carroll County. However, due to a severe loss of integrity, it is no longer a good example of the type. The rear elevation and first story of the front elevation are obscured by incompatible new additions.




