The Rittenhouse-Dieterich House (CARR-1705) is located at 21 Pleasant Valley Road. Built c. 1900, this two-story I-House has an exterior that is clad in vinyl siding and a side-gabled roof that is covered in standing-seam metal. The house rests on a solid foundation of randomly laid stone. The front porch is a one-story, three-bay structure supported by turned wooden posts. A narrow transom is above the front entry. A brick chimney is located at each interior end of the roof, and a third chimney is in the interior portion of a rear two-story addition. A one-story extension of the rear addition displays a hipped roof. A two-story gabled addition has been appended to the east elevation. The original windows have been replaced with one-over-one aluminum sash windows, but there are a few two-over-two wooden double-hung sash windows intact.

East of the house is a one-story garage clad in corrugated metal with a gabled roof covered in standing-seam metal. Also to the east is a wooden shed clad in vertical boards with a shed roof covered in standing-seam metal. Southwest of the house is shed, which is clad in board-and-batten siding with a gabled roof covered in corrugated metal.

This dwelling exhibits a design common for the period. This resource has no apparent association with any event or person significant in our nation's history, lacks architectural significance, and does not appear to have the ability to yield important

information. In addition, multiple alterations including vinyl siding, new windows, and several additions diminish the architectural integrity of the house. The Rittenhouse-Dieterich house is recommended as not eligible for the NRHP under Criteria A, B, C, or D.



In addition, multiple alterations diminish the architectural integrity of the house. The Rittenhouse-Dieterich house is recommended as not eligible for the NRHP under Criteria A, B, C, or D.




