CARR-221 Henrietta Dugan House

Harriet Jones, a black woman, bought two lots (3216 and 3300 Uniontown Road) from the estate of Martin Billmyer for \$274 in 1857. It is difficult to determine exactly what the improvements were on these lots, but there was probably a log house at **3216 Uniontown Road** at the time of their purchase. Underneath the brick facade of this house is a log structure that may have been constructed as early as 1832, when Billmyer acquired the lot for \$25. Jones sold this single lot to Henrietta Dugan for \$535 in 1862, the price indicating that she had made substantial improvements to the house. The details of the remodeling, with its stretcher bond brick facade, two-over-two sash windows, and wood lintels with corner blocks, are representative features of the mid-nineteenth century. The remodeling also included a wing at the rear of the house which interestingly has a brick facade on the west side facing Uniontown but wood siding on the east side.


