CARR-223 William Smith House

The 1875 equity court case regarding the estate of John B. Williams provides the following description of **3208 Uniontown Road**: "a log house with a weatherboarded addition, an excellent well of water near the door, a log stable, and a greater portion of the land planted with fruit trees." Williams had acquired the property from William Smith, who probably built the house during the mid-nineteenth century.


