The 1875 equity court case regarding the estate of John B. Williams lists a log house at **3204 Uniontown Road**. The house was previously owned by the Jacob Smith family and was probably built by them during the mid-nineteenth century. The house is currently covered in an imitation brick asphalt siding.


