CARR- 228 Samuel Brown House

During the late nineteenth century, the east end of Uniontown was a small community of black residents. **3317 Uniontown Road** was owned by a black man named Samuel Brown. The property was part of the George Harris estate purchased by Jesse T. H. Davis. As a structure is not shown on either the 1862 or 1877 maps, the house appears to have been built circa 1881 and sold by Davis to Brown. A later resident was Julia Ann Trite.



DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small structure, an obvious oddity in its architectural concept, stands to the rear of Carr 228.

That portion of this 2 part composition that is at the N. end is a slightly rectangular block with an "A" roof running E-W and possessing an interior chimney at its W. gable. The W. end has an off center plank door; the N. elevation is unbroken; and the E. end has a single door, centered, at ground level with a window, door directly above at the gable level. At the S. elevation there is a small window and an addition. (well house) ^{the size of} which is elevated above that ~~same~~ ^{same} line of the 1st. block. This addition has a pyramid roof and the only opening is a door at its W. elevation.

Note: There actually are too many openings in the 1st. block for use as a smoke house so, until access to the interior is gained, it may be conjectured that due to its relation (structural) to the well it may ~~serve~~ have served as a spring house.
