CARR-229 James M Slemmons House

3321 Uniontown Road is an early log house that appears in the 1837 tax assessment under the ownership of James M. Slemmons. Later owners were Susan Smith (1865) and Annie Wilson Heltibridle (1886). While the exterior is covered in a modern siding, you can still distinguish early features in the house through its L-shape plan, proportion, and six-over-nine windows on the first story.


