CARR-231 Harvey Erb House

3329 Uniontown Road was constructed about 1892 by Harvey Erb. It is a transitional structure that portrays the changing architectural style from the late Victorian period to the early twentieth century. The gable-front main facade and the ornamental details, such as the ornate porch brackets and bargeboard in the gable, are strongly rooted in the Victorian period. The two-section windows on the second story of the main facade are a feature that became popular in all of the early twentieth century styles.


