DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Englar's Mill House stands on the North side of Sma's Creek Road at Englar's Mill and is of brick construction.

The South elevation (front) is two storeys in height and possesses five bays in length. Windows are 2/2 pane Victorian sash and the centered door has what appears to be a simple traceried fanlight. Also at the S. elevation is a one storey Victorian porch. The eaves are boxed in a simple design.

The roof plan is A frame with a single interior chimney at each end. Both stacks are approx. four feet in width. At the center of the roof ridge is a open cupola of simple design which houses a farm bell.

To the N. elevation (rear) and appearing from the road to be independent of the main block, is a one storey kitchen having an A roof running N. to S. with a large exterior brick chimney at its N. end.
