1420 Old New Windsor Road is a representative farmstead from the mid-to-late nineteenth century. The house is constructed in the regional farmhouse style with an L-shaped plan built into a bank. Late nineteenth century ornamentation, such as the gabled dormer and full-length porch have been added to the structure. Other buildings on the property include a smokehouse, washhouse, chickenhouse, shed, and late 19th century bank barn.
