1130 Old Westminster Road is one of several small mid-nineteenth century log houses along the Old Westminster Road. The houses probably served as residences and places of business for craftsman who helped the surrounding farmers. The houses are relatively plain L-shaped structures two stories in height with a plain symmetrical three-bay main facade. Remodeling of 1130 Old Westminster Road has obscured its early details.


