38 Tannery Road is one of the few buildings that remains from when the village of Tannery was a thriving depot and industrial site. It is a unusual shaped building for this region with its catslide-style roof. The main facade faces east with the south gable-end facade facing the railroad tracks. On the south facade is a bay window. The house also retains it curvilinear design bargeboard and cornice trim. The Victorian-style ornamentation that is still on the building gives some evidence of the prosperity of Tannery and the influence of the railroad in this region.
