306 West Main Street is a two-story, three-bay by one-bay structure in an L-shaped plan. It is a late nineteenth century building that has the basic characteristics of the regional farmhouse. The full-length, one-story porch is a replacement of an earlier porch; evidence of the design of the earlier porch can be seen in the engaged half-column at the rear of the porch on the west side.
