1461 Old Manchester Road retains several of its Victorian style ornamental features including a projecting, five-sided bay window at the southwest corner of the house. The house has the basic characteristics of the regional farmhouse, but is embellished through its bay window and a gabled dormer. Modern alterations have probably destroyed other Victorian style details, such as the centrally located front door and the front porch ornamentation. The house is shown on both of the 1862 and 1877 maps of Carroll County in the village of Mexico.


