1132 Martin Drive is shown as the Mrs. Stone residence on the 1877 map. As it does not appear on the 1862 map, the house was probably constructed between those years. It is probably a log structure that has been remodeled several times. The exterior currently has a white aluminum siding with red aluminum shutters. The building is constructed into a slope with a full basement level on the main facade--a popular log building style in this region.
