629 Lucabaugh Mill Road is the mill owner's house for the Bankert and Lucabaugh Mill complex. It is shown on the 1862 and 1877 maps as the J. Bankert residence with a grist mill and saw mill on the property. It is believed that the original stone house was built in 1811. It is a two-bay bank house with a full-basement level on the east facade. On the south gable end of the structure, a modern brick addition has been added. The property also has a frame bank barn with a stone-fenced barnyard and a corn crib/wagon shed.
