Description of Property and Justification: *(Please attach map and photo)*

The Calhoun House (CARR-751) is located at 61 Old Bachman's ^{Valley} Road. Built c. 1870, this two-story house has been clad in stucco and is void of exterior ornamentation that may reflect its construction date. The house is shown at this location on the 1877 Westminster map, but not on the c. 1862 map (Martinet c.1862). The house is three-bays wide and three-bays deep. The exterior walls are clad in stucco, and the side-gabled roof is covered in composition shingles. The original windows have been replaced with one-over-one aluminum sash windows with decorative shutters. The northeast elevation features a new brick chimney and a one-story shed-roofed addition that is partially clad in vinyl siding. The front entry is a simple modern door with no porch or surround. Northeast of the house is a shed (smoker) and a one-bay garage. The smoker is entirely clad in 5-V crimp metal, and the garage features exterior walls clad in T-111 siding, and a gabled roof covered in composition shingles. Southeast of the house is a small wooden frame shed with a gabled roof.

This dwelling exhibits a design common for the period. This resource has no apparent association with any event or person significant in our nation's history, lacks architectural significance, and does not appear to have the ability to yield important information. In addition, multiple alterations including the stuccoed exterior, replaced windows, side addition, removed front porch, and new roofing material diminish the architectural integrity of the house. The Calhoun House is recommended as not

Resource Sketch Map







61 Old Bachman's Valley Road is difficult to analyze from the exterior. The two-story, three-bay by two-bay house is covered in stucco and has all modern exterior features, including its windows, roof, and chimney. Its proportions, however, give the appearance that an earlier structure might be beneath all of the modern materials.


