551 Sullivan Road is a mid-nineteenth century log house. It is built into a slope so that the main (west) facade has a full story at its stone foundation level. There is a full-length double-tiered porch on the main facade. The ell wing appears to be a later addition to the original structure. The house is a substantial building for its time and represents one facet of the log house tradition in the county. There is also a stone outbuilding on the property.
