1701 Nelson Road is an example of the rural Victorian style architecture in Carroll County as adapted from the pattern books of the period. Major features of the house are its T-shaped plan, wrap-around porch with turned posts, bay windows, and ornamented windows in the doors. The current paint color scheme shows the use of two colors to enhance the trim, such as the cornerboards, cornice, and window frames, by use of a second color.


