1100 Poole Road is an unusual house because of its shape, form and massing. It is a one-story structure built into a slope so that there is a full basement on the main (north) and east facade. The structure is common bond brick on a fieldstone foundation. The main facade is two bays wide and has a double-tiered porch. The entrance on the first story has a transom and sidelights.
