923 Poole Road is a representative log house of the mid-nineteenth century. It is two stories high on a stone foundation. The house is built into a slope so that there is a full basement level on the main (east) facade. The asymmetrical facade and the location of the chimney suggest that the house was constructed in two sections. The house has been remodeled with aluminum siding on the exterior and an enclosed front porch.


