902 Old Westminster Pike is a six-bay by one-bay structure with a long horizontal profile. It appears to have been built in two sections of which the earliest one is log. The exterior is covered in German siding and there is a full-length, one-story porch with turned posts. The property contains several small outbuildings. The rectangular plan of the structure shows a variation of the regional farmhouse style.




